Park Advisory Board - MINUTES

1. Call to Order

Courtney Meyer called the meeting to order at 6:30 p.m.

2. Roll Call

The following board members were present:

Craig Mellon, Wes Spohr and Tawny Fisher. Samantha Dillon and Connie Fleming were absent

3. Approval of the February 20, 2020 Meeting Notes

Motion: *Spohr* moved, *Fisher* seconded to approve the minutes. Voted and passed unanimously.

4. Financials

- a. Meyer went over the 2020 budget again. There is still approximately \$19,000 to schedule to spend in 2020 otherwise it will transfer to the next year.

5. Business

a. Concession Stand & Shelter Update

Meyer explained that the Mayor is considering the option of having the concession stand and the shelter bonded since the projects are large. We should know more for the next Park Advisory Meeting.

b. Pickleball Courts

Samantha Dillon was not able to report if the pricing from MidAmerican Courtworks was still valid. Meyer did report that another quote was received from Multicon and their price was around \$30,000. Mid American Courtworks price in 2019 was around \$13,000.

c. Project List

Logan Mills brought a map of the sports complex along with "to scale" pictures of a basketball court, pocket park, picnic area, splash pad, and sand volleyball court. The Board reviewed locations for the items that had been discussed at previous meetings to add to the parks. Logan stated he didn't bring estimated pricing with him but would email everyone estimated prices of the different areas so the Board could better decide a roll out plan. Chadd Posch added to the list to consider benches along the Chisholm Trail walking path and possibly drinking fountains at both parks.

The Board discussed if the council decides to bond the two large projects then there will be \$60,000 to go towards another project also it would free up future funds for other "smaller" projects for the parks.

Logan Mills shared with he Board that a sidewalk will be installed next to the new road that will lead from Ross Ave into Park Glen Estates. He suggested that it might be cheaper to pour additional concrete sidewalks for pads at that time than to try and have it done separately. The Board will review and come up with a placement plan for the new items in the Sports Complex to take to Council for their approval. If a placement can be decided and approved the concrete

might be able to be poured at the time when the sidewalk is poured.
